## GOVERNMENT ORDER NO. FD 11 SRP 2023, BENGALURU, DATED 1<sup>ST</sup> JUNE 2023.

Government are pleased to enhance the rates of Dearness Allowance in respect of the serving State Judicial Service Officers on 2016 Revised NJPC Scales of Pay and in respect of retired Judicial Officers on 2016 Revised NJPC scale of pay from the existing rate of 38% to 42% of the Basic Pay and Basic Pension as the case may be with effect from 1st January 2023.

- 2. For the purpose of this order, the term 'Basic Pay' means, the pay drawn by the Government Servant in the 2016 NJPC Pay Scale applicable to the post held by him.
  - 3. Basic Pay shall not include any other emoluments not classed as pay.
- 4. The Dearness Allowance admissible under this order is payable in cash until further orders.
- 5. These orders are not applicable to retired Judicial Officers on 2006 Revised NJPC Pay Scales retired prior to 01.01.2016. Separate orders will be issued in this regard.
- 6. The payment of arrears of Dearness Allowance shall not be made before the date of disbursement of salary for the month of May 2023.
- 7. The payment on account of Dearness Allowance involving fractions of 50 paise and above shall be rounded off to the next rupee and fractions less than 50 paise shall be ignored.

8. The Dearness Allowance will be shown as a distinct element of remuneration and will not be treated as pay for any purpose.
