GOVERNMENT ORDER NO. FD 20 SRP 2023, BANGALORE, DATED 27th OCTOBER 2023.

Government are pleased to revise the rates of Dearness Allowance in respect of the serving State Judicial Service Officers on 2016 NJPC Scales of Pay from the existing **42% to 46%** of the Basic Pay with effect from **1st July 2023**.

2. Government are also pleased to revise the Dearness Allowance rates of the retired Judicial Officers/Family Pensioners to **46%** of the Basic Pension/Family Pension as the case may be with effect from **1st July 2023**.

3. For the purpose of this order, the term 'Basic Pay' and Basic Pension/Family Pension means, the Basic Pay drawn by the serving Judicial Officer in the 2016 Revised NJPC Pay Scale applicable to the post held by him and revised Basic Pension/Family Pension as provided in G.O. No. LAW-LCE/214/2022(P-5) dated:24.08.2023 respectively.

4. The Pensioner/Family Pensioner is entitled to the benefit of revised Dearness Allowance from the date his/her pension is revised as per the G.O. dated: 24.08.2023.

5. Basic Pay or Basic Pension shall not include any other emoluments not classed as pay or pension as the case may be.

6. The Dearness Allowance admissible under this order is payable in cash until further orders.

7. The payment of arrears of Dearness Allowance shall not be made before the date of disbursement of salary/revised pension for the month of October 2023.

8. The payment on account of Dearness Allowance involving fractions of 50 paise and above shall be rounded off to the next rupee and fractions less than 50 paise shall be ignored.

9. The Dearness Allowance will be shown as a distinct element of remuneration and will not be treated as pay for any purpose.
