GOVERNMENT ORDER NO. FD 20 SRP 2024, BENGALURU, DATED 15TH MARCH 2024.

Government are pleased to revise the rates of Dearness Allowance in respect of the serving State Judicial Service Officers on 2016 Revised NJPC Scales of Pay from the existing rate of 46% to 50% of the Basic Pay with effect from 1st January 2024.

- 2. Government are also pleased to revise the Dearness Allowance rates of the retired Judicial Officers / Family Pensioners from the existing 46% to 50% of the Basic Pension / Family Pension as the case may be with effect from 1st January 2024.
- 3. For the purpose of this order, the term 'Basic Pay' and Basic Pension / Family Pension means, the Basic Pay drawn by the serving Judicial Officer in the 2016 Revised NJPC Pay Scale applicable to the post held by him and revised Basic Pension / Family Pension respectively.
- 4. Basic Pay or Basic Pension shall not include any other emoluments not classed as pay or pension as the case may be.
- 5. The Dearness Allowance admissible under this order is payable in cash until further orders.
- 6. The payment of arrears of Dearness Allowance shall not be made before the date of disbursement of salary / pension for the month of March 2024.

- 7. The payment on account of Dearness Allowance involving fractions of 50 paise and above shall be rounded off to the next rupee and fractions less than 50 paise shall be ignored.
- 8. The Dearness Allowance will be shown as a distinct element of remuneration and will not be treated as pay for any purpose.
