



PROCEEDINGS OF THE GOVERNMENT OF KARNATAKA

Sub:- Revision of the rates of Dearness Allowance payable in 2024 Revised Pay Scales and Revised Pension -reg.

PREAMBLE:

In the light of the recommendations of the 7th State Pay Commission constituted by the State Government, a policy decision has been taken to implement the recommendations of the Pay Commission pertaining to revision of pay scales and pension. Accordingly, in G.Os. dated: 23.08.2024 and 28.08.2024 read at (1) and (2) above respectively, detailed orders were issued implementing the 2024 Revised Pay Scales and Revised Pension w.e.f. 01.08.2024.

In G.O. dated: 23.08.2024 provisions are also made to regulate the grant of dearness allowance to State Government employees and State Government pensioners.

The State Government have considered the orders of the Government of India read at (3) and (4) above revising the rates of dearness allowance and dearness relief to the Central Government employees. Accordingly, the following orders are issued.

**GOVERNMENT ORDER NO. FD 43 SRP 2024,
BANGALORE, DATED 27th NOVEMBER 2024.**

Government are pleased to enhance the rates of Dearness Allowance payable to the State Government Employees on the 2024 Revised State Pay Scales from the existing 8.50% to 10.75% of the Basic Pay with effect from 1st July 2024.

However, the monetary benefit of the revised rates of dearness allowance is admissible w.e.f. **1st August 2024**.

2. For the purpose of this order, the term 'Basic Pay' means, pay drawn by a Government Employee in the scale of pay applicable to the post held by him and includes:

- a. Stagnation increment, if any, granted to him above the maximum of the scale of pay in 2024 Revised Pay Scales;
- b. Personal Pay, if any, granted to him under sub-rule (3) of Rule 7 read with Rule 3(c) of the Karnataka Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 2024;
- c. Additional increment, if any, granted to him above the maximum of the scale of pay applicable to the post.

3. For the purpose of grant of dearness allowance the basic pay shall not include any emoluments other than those specified above.

4. Government are also pleased to enhance the rates of Dearness Allowance from the existing **8.50% to 10.75%** of the Basic Pension/Family Pension with effect from **1st July 2024** to the State Government Pensioners/Family Pensioners as well as to the Pensioners/Family Pensioners of the Aided Educational Institutions whose Pension/ Family Pension is paid out of the Consolidated Fund of the State. However, the monetary benefit of the revised rates of dearness allowance is admissible w.e.f. **1st August 2024**.

5. For the purpose of grant of dearness allowance the basic pension/family pension shall not include any other emoluments not specified in Rule 3 of KCS(RP) Rules, 2024 and orders issued thereunder.

6. These orders are also applicable to the retired employees of the UGC/AICTE/ICAR scales of pay.

7. These orders will apply to the full time Government Employees, Employees of Zilla Panchayats, Work Charged Employees on regular time scales

of pay, full time Employees of the Aided Educational Institutions and Universities on regular time scales of pay.

8. Separate orders will be issued in respect of Employees on UGC/AICTE/ICAR scales of pay and in respect of Judicial Officers on NJPC Pay Scale.

9. The increase in Dearness Allowance admissible under this order is payable in cash.

10. The payment on account of revision of dearness allowance involving fractions of 50 paise and above shall be rounded off to the next rupee and fractions less than 50 paise shall be ignored.

11. The payment of arrears of dearness allowance admissible under this order shall not be payable before the date of disbursement of salary for the month of December 2024.

12. The dearness allowance will be shown as a distinct element of remuneration and shall not be treated as pay for any purpose.
